In exercise of the power conferred by Rule 9 of the Mizoram Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes(Regulation of Issuance and Verification of Community Certificates Rules, 2023, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to constitute Vigilance Cell in each District of Mizoram to assist the Scrutiny Committee for conducting enquiry with the following composition:

1. Deputy Superintendent (Hqrs.) of each District
2. Inspector of Police in the Office of each District S.P
3. Officer in Charge of Police Station/Out Post concerned in each District

Duty and responsibilities:

1. To investigate into the social status claim and visit the local place of residence and original place from which the applicant hails and usually resides or in case of migration to the town or city, the place from which he/she originally hailed from;
2. To verify and collect all the facts of the social status claimed by the candidate/applicant or the parent or guardian, as the case may be;
3. To examine the school records, birth registration, if any;
4. To examine the parent, guardian or the candidate/applicant in relation to their tribe/caste etc or such other persons who have knowledge of the social status of the candidate;
5. To submit report to the Scrutiny Committee with all particulars of the Scheduled Tribes/Scheduled Castes relating to their peculiar anthropological and ethnological traits, deity, rituals, customs, mode of marriage, death ceremonies, method of burial of dead bodies etc by the concerned tribes or castes communities etc clearly indicating the opinion of the Vigilance Cell regarding the social status of the candidate/applicant.
